



Storm Procedures

Hurricane Season is June 1st – November 30th

At Trinity Episcopal Church, we have implemented the following storm policy:

When Indian River County is under a **Tropical Storm Watch** or **Tropical Storm Warning**, the office will remain open. Be cautious when travelling during this time. If you are scheduled for a meeting or an event at Trinity Episcopal Church, call ahead to be sure that the event has not been canceled or rescheduled.

When Indian River County is under a **Hurricane Watch*** of a named storm, the office will remain open while we begin preparing to secure our facilities. Be cautious if you must travel during this time. If you are scheduled for a meeting or an event at Trinity Episcopal Church, call ahead to be sure that the event has not been canceled or rescheduled.

**Hurricane Watch – Hurricane conditions possible within the next 48 hrs.*

When Indian River County is under a **Hurricane Warning*** of a named storm, the office will be closed. Please check our website and Facebook page for updates about worship cancellations.

**Hurricane Warning – Hurricane conditions are expected within 36 hrs.*
