Is the public allowed to attend this meeting?

Yes. Members of the public are invited and encouraged to attend Committee meetings. When meetings are held via Go To Meeting, the public may attend using the following process:

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Persons wishing to comment are asked to indicate that they would like to speak during the public comment period and indicate the topic of their comments when they sign-in or introduce themselves before the meeting. They will be allotted three minutes to make their comments. Written summaries of public comments are appreciated so that public comments will be accurately reflected in Committee meeting minutes. Staff respectfully requests that you submit 15 copies of written materials at the time of your presentation and, if possible, an electronic copy of the materials to staff 24 hours prior to the meeting.

What if the Committee enters into Executive Session?

Prior to entering into executive session the Committee Chair will announce the nature of and the authority for holding executive session, at which time all audience members will be asked to leave the room with the exception of news media and designated staff.

Executive session will be held in accordance with ORS 192.660.

No final actions or final decisions will be made in executive session. The Committee will return to open session before taking any final action or making any final decisions.

Who do I contact if I have questions or need special accommodations?
