Carmenere

A powerful leafy and spicy nose leave place to a perfect balance of raspberry, green peppercorn and bell pepper. A different wine from the usual New World style wines that will please both Gentleman and Ladies.

Oveja Negra, Winemaker's Selection, Maule Valley, Chile 2014 bottle £24.00
Cabernet Syrah

A full flavoured blend with a touch of mint and herbaceous fruit combined with cassis.

Carmen 'Reserva', San Antonio, Chile 2016 bottle £28.00
Pinot Noir

Intense deep garnet red Pinot Noir from Casablanca Valley. The complex notes of strawberry, dark plum and dry cherries are exalted by the spiciness of light touch of oak.

Echeverria 'Propuesta', Maipo Valley, Chile 2013 bottle £25.00
Cabernet Sauvignon, Malbec, Petit Verdot

Fancy a Cote du Rhone style wine? Elegant red fruit and smoke on the nose followed by berries, green pepper and tobacco with long and smooth tannins will elevate your rib-eye to heaven.

Piattelli 'Alto Molino', Cafayate, Argentina 2015 bottle £27.00
Malbec

Cafayate is for me the most interesting wine region in Argentina. Situated at the extreme north of Salta. Here wine is made between 1500mt up to 3500mt above sea level, giving this malbec a purity of flavour that hardly any other can reach.

Perez Cruz 'Reserva', Maipo Valley, Chile 2014 bottle £30.00
Cabernet Sauvignon

Bursting flavours of ripe blackberries and currant accompanied by black pepper, figs and cinnamon. An iconic Cabernet from Perez Cruz Single Estate that speaks both for the stony Maipo soils and the winemakers passion for Bordeaux wine. You won't regret your usual Malbec.

Full Bodied, Intense and Spicy

Andeluna '1300', Mendoza, Argentina 2016 Malbec

Dark plum, raspberry and stewed fruit in the mouth with a smoked and chocolatey long finish.

Piattelli 'High Altitude Premium', Cafayate, Argentina 2015 Malbec, Tannat

bottle £35.00

Two of my favourite grapes blends together in this powerful expression of the Cafayate terroir. Growing at an incredibly high altitudes (1960mt). Malbec provides juicy fruit and silkiness while Tannat add spice and power to the body, iconic!

Riccitelli, 'Vineyard Selection', Salta, Argentina 2013 Cabernet Sauvignon

Big, Bold and Spicy, Piattelli Cabernet is a powerful fist in a velvet glove. Ripe and elegant Blackfruit notes with secondary aromas of Christmas spices and Violets. 12 months in French Oak and 20 years old vines gives this Cabernet powerful and polished tannins. Perfect with marbled steak.

Riccitelli "The Apple doesn't fall far from the Tree" Mendoza, Argentina 2015 Bonarda

This is an excellent alternative to the usual Malbec, with smoother tannins and more earth and gamey notes, Bonarda can perfectly pair even a delicate Blue Fillet.



Special Bottlings

This special bottle selection is composed by some particularly good expression of a single Terroir in South America. They go further than being a good wine. They speak loud about where they grow and age, about all the hardwork needed to give all the nuances you can taste when you drink them.

Andeluna 'Altitud', Tupungato, Chile 2014 Malbec

bottle £40.00

High Altitud Malbec is the iconic wine that Argentina has to offer. Andeluna is the demonstration of how good winemakers can make good terroir and grape shine. Elegance and balance is the key here, with the classic stewed plum and dark red fruits aroma enriched by vanilla and chai spices from the aging in French Oak with further 8 months in the winemaker cellars. The finish is long and mineral, with rich and savoury tannins which never overshines the meat flavour.

Perez Cruz 'Chasky', Maipo Valley, Chile 2013 Petit Verdot

'Chasky' fascinates us for many reasons. It's extremely hard to find Petit Verdot by itself in a wine. This grape originating in Bordeaux gives powerful and mineral red wine, with notes of red fruits, tobacco, herbs, spices which never overpower the meat, being a perfect complement of flavours instead. Fans of Bordeaux and Margaux will particularly enjoy this bottle.

Viña Echeverria 'Family Reserve', Maipo Valley, Chile 2012 Cabernet Sauvignon, Syrah, Carmenere

The huge personality of Roberto Echeverria is reflecting in this big and bold wine from his top-quality vineyards in Maipo Valley. Deep garnet red in colour with amber gleams, blackberries, cherry and strawberry compote combine nicely with eucalyptus and menthol aromas. Layers of chocolate and spices gives a smooth and mouthfilling sensation, creating a balanced and distinctive wine.

Matias Riccitelli 'Republica Del Malbec', Lujan de Cuyo, Argentina 2014 Malbec

Riccitelli flagship's wine "Republica Del Malbec" is a fusion of power and elegance. The 100 years old vines provides an exceptional concentration of ripe blueberry and blackberry, cherry layered with tobacco and leather, savoury and silky tannins keeping a nice fresh and long finish.
