Lansing Art Gallery \$1,500

Lansing Art Gallery's Summer Art Camp program provides visual arts experiences focusing on creativity, technique, critique, and vocabulary. Lansing Art Gallery will provide twenty seventy-five dollar scholarships to youth ages 7 - 12 to attend a one-week session of summer art camp. These half-day camps take place between June 23 and August 7, 2014. Sessions are taught by professional artists and are held 9:00 AM - 12:00 PM and 1:00 - 4:00 PM, Monday through Thursday. Activities will take place at Lansing Art Gallery located at 119 N. Washington Square in downtown Lansing.

MSU Community Music School \$1,500

The MSU Community Music School will award \$1,500 in financial assistance to students with need, ages 5-17 years old, to attend one of CMS's six summer music camps between June 9 and August 8, 2014. All camps take place on the MSU campus, either at CMS or at the Music and Music Practice Buildings.

REACH Studio Art Center \$900

Paint, Print, Draw, Sculpt, Make Costumes and Puppets, and Play with Clay this summer at REACH Studio Art Center. REACH will present 12 (\$75 each) scholarships to offer Lansing Area youth ages 6-13 to attend 1/2 or full day week art camps to take place between June 16 and August 21, 2014 at REACH in Lansing, Michigan.

Wharton Center for the Performing Arts \$700

Wharton Center's Education Institute will present 5 partial scholarships to students ages 9-17 to attend a Broadway-themed camp, Take it from the Top, July 28 - August 1 at Wharton Center located in East Lansing, MI. The musical theatre workshops give participants the opportunity to explore music, dance, and theatre with Broadway professionals in a safe and fun environment. Participants learn the craft of musical theatre from basic to advanced skills. Students who look into the community for educational opportunities can be involved in something they are passionate about. Students receive guidance from professional mentors which builds their confidence.
