Lansing Art Gallery \$1,250

Lansing Art Gallery's 2017 Spring Break and Summer Art Camps will provide six weeks of visual arts experiences for students ages 7 - 15. Sessions are led by professional artists and focus on creativity, technique, critique, and vocabulary. Lansing Art Gallery will provide scholarships, based on financial need, in the amount of \$1,500 for the attendance of half-day or full-day camps. Sessions are held Monday through Friday and will take place between April 3 and August 11, 2017. Activities will take place at Lansing Art Gallery located in downtown Lansing at 119 North Washington Square.

MSU Community Music School \$1,250

MSU Community Music School will provide \$1,500 in financial assistance for children, ages 5 to 17, to attend one of CMS' summer music camps held between June 12 and August 4, 2017, in East Lansing, Michigan. Through the summer camp and financial assistance programs, music education is made accessible to youth in our community and offered in a fun, engaging and inclusive way.

Native American Arts and Crafts Council \$1,250

The Native American Arts and Crafts Council will present an Education Day June 2 in cooperation with the annual Riverbank Traditional Pow Wow at the Louis Adado Riverfront Park in Lansing, Michigan. Students from the Lansing School District, Home School groups, and Lansing area Charter Academies will be invited to participate. This is a free program to students from the Lansing School District. There will be a nominal charge for Home School Students and the Charter Students.

REACH Studio Art Center \$1,250

REACH Studio Art Center will implement a Summer Outreach Project with 2 FREE summer neighborhood art camp weeks and 1 week of free summer art workshops for youth ages 5-13. The 2 camps (each 4 half-days) and workshop week (3 half-days) will give up to 60 youth from the low income neighborhoods surrounding REACH, the opportunity for summer learning through art.

Red Cedar Writing Project \$1,250

Red Cedar Writing Project will present six \$225 scholarships to students aged 5 to 14 to attend one-week summer writing camps to take place between June 1, 2017 and July 31, 2017 at Michigan State University located in East Lansing, Michigan.

Wharton Center for Performing Arts \$1,250

Wharton Center will present approximately 12-17 partial scholarships to students ages 7 to 25 to attend a one-week musical theatre intensive camp to take place between July 24, 2017 and July 29, 2017 at Wharton Center for Performing Arts in East Lansing, MI.
